Missions Update - Walid & Rima Bitar - Part 1

Also, I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me." Isaiah 6:8

Dear Pastors, Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Maranatha,

What a blessing and joy to answer "send me". We received an invitation to serve in Lebanon last July. Many people asked us for medications. The economy collapsed and people lost hope. It was a great time serving and encouraging people and churches and speaking in an outreach conference. People did not have gas to attend the conference. We rented buses so people could come. We visited those in need, and distributed medications. A man asked if we could help him with a medication called Omnic Ocas. He needed the medication daily. We are working to provide him the medication from here in Ottawa.

Difficulties make people ready to hear the Gospel. Before we left Beirut I had a headache. Rima and I tested positive for Covid 19. Then I had fever. Our concern was that most hospitals were facing shortages in fuel, oxygen and medications. The Lord protected us but we were delayed in returning. I was asked the Lord why this happened when I received three voice messages from people needing prayer.

1. Elie, the taxi driver, said thank you for giving me a Bible. I was waiting in line hours to get gas. I opened the Bible and read it and benefited from what is in it.
2. Mahmoud, a Syrian refugee, came to the conference. I talked to him. He shared about his family's difficulties. I shared the Gospel with him. The next day he said his wife in Turkey talked to him and wants to come back to rebuild the family. He called his friend and said the Lord answered his prayer. He called me saying "Yes, Jesus is alive. I will go to church with my friend."
3. We gave Colette a book about the miracles of Jesus. She shared it with her friend. Since reading it she feels different.
